

MOUNTAIN SPRINGS CHURCH 2020 MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

LOCAL RESPONSE

We provided \$9,000 for the **Fresh Start Center** to kick off its new **Community Nurse Program**.

Gift cards were given to 185 staff members from **Falcon Middle School** and **Pioneer Elementary School** during the height of COVID-19. We also were able to hold a lunch for the teachers and staff at Pioneer.

We provided \$2,000 for **Habitat for Humanity's new home repair program** to help seniors, disabled and low income homeowners.

In 2020, we have 328 members involved in **CarePortal**. Together, they have responded to the needs of over 900 kids with an economic impact of over \$230,000!

We provided resources (\$2,700 value) for families in crisis through the **D49 Community Engagement Team**. These resources will be used for families and staff members in the district who are struggling.

Through **Sarah's Home Educational Fund**, we have provided over \$14,000 for girls' post-program education. We were recently able to provide a \$2,000 scholarship for a graduate who was accepted into cosmetology school.

We provided a year of internet access for **50 families in D11** to help with their online education.

We are helping **Restore Innocence** (a human trafficking ministry) with shelving for their new facilities as well as \$10,000 worth of ministry supplies for their Restoration Bags. These bags are used by the FBI when they rescue victims.

GLOBAL RESPONSE



COVID-19 RELIEF FUNDS

We were able to bless our ministry partners in Eswatini, Uganda and Brazil with some emergency COVID-19 resources (\$15,000) to help their communities. These resources provided emergency food rations for hundreds of children and their families. It also provided resources to keep the Musana Camp clinic open during this pandemic.



MYANMAR CHURCH PLANTING

We sent \$12,000 to support church planting missionaries working with Uncharted International.



RAY OF HOPE AMAZON JUNGLE PARTNERS

We sent \$6,000 to help support 9 jungle pastors who are spreading the gospel in remote areas of the Amazon rainforest.



UGANDA FAMILY GROUP SUPPORT

We sent \$12,000 to become the church anchor for the Jeremiah Family with New Hope Uganda. This family is raising 26 children, many of whom were rescued from the LRA in the war torn area of Kobwin. This will be our flagship family group that we will work alongside of when we send teams.



ONECHILD SPONSORSHIP

We gave \$50,000 in November to launch our new Hope Center partnership in Haiti and the Philippines.
